



ESOS

With less than 6 months to comply, are you ready?

ESOS is a mandatory energy auditing scheme affecting around 7,000 companies in the UK. Latest research shows that around a quarter of affected companies are yet to act, despite the impending compliance deadline of 5th December 2015.

ESOS compliance can only be met via Lead Assessor approval, who are energy efficiency experts registered with the Environment Agency, or via ISO 50001 certification. It is important that affected companies understand the level of work required to meet ESOS Lead Assessor approval and compliance over the next six months.

ESOS goes way beyond just a data collection exercise as some companies initially believe. Collecting formal energy data with evidence, and carrying out full energy audits is a timely exercise, hence action should be taken soon. Failure to comply with ESOS regulation can lead to significant fines and penalties.

QUALIFICATION

- ✓ Undertakings with over 250 employees
- ✓ Undertakings with an annual turnover exceeding €50m **and** a balance sheet exceeding €43m
- ✓ Undertakings that are part of a corporate group with a qualifying undertaking

ACTIONS

1. **Reference Year Data:** Collate 100% of energy consumption, with evidential records, across buildings, industrial processes and transport
2. **Determine significant energy usage:** A boundary illustrating where 90% of energy is used must be drawn for auditing
3. **ESOS compliant energy audits:** The 90% energy boundary must be subject to energy audits to identify 'energy saving opportunities'
4. **Board approval:** ESOS audits and the evidence pack must be signed off by a board member
5. **Lead assessor approval:** ESOS evidence packs must be signed off by an Environment Agency Approved Lead Assessor to meet compliance
